Te Ōhaakii ā Hine — National Network for Ending Sexual Violence Together (TOAH-NNEST) invites proposals for presentations and workshops for the bi-annual National Sexual Violence Conference 2024.

About the Conference

The conference will be held in Christchurch on the 19th and 20th of November 2024. The theme of this year's conference "Te Tāmata Tipu" is about restoring growth and vitality. Tāmata is to cultivate and work the soil and tipu is the seedling. Te Tāmata Tipu is about creating the conditions for the seedlings to grow again and prosper. There have been some challenging conditions, and it is imperative to ensure the soils are right for them to grow and thrive. This theme was gifted to us by Dr Eruera Tarena (Ngāi Tahu, Ngāti Porou, Te Whānau-ā-Apanui).

We are honoured to have this theme for our 2024 conference as it builds upon previous TOAH-NNEST mahi and the strength of those who have and continue to work in this sector.

The Kaupapa of the conference is to bring those working in the mahi tūkino (sexual violence) sector together to whanaungatanga (build relationships), workshop, share knowledge and be informed from specialists in this sector. TOAH-NNEST want to create an environment that enriches and encourages healing for all that have been impacted by Sexual Violence.

Workshop Proposal Information

We are seeking proposals that include an understanding of Te Ao Māori and reflect the diversity of those impacted by mahi tūkino. We are looking for exciting and inspiring ideas, collaborative approaches, and responses to ending mahi tūkino, prevention, healing, justice, and community leadership among Māori and Tauiwi.

This can include proposals from kaimahi, academics, researchers, practitioners, educators, activists, and policy makers. Presenters are encouraged to engage participants through interactive and participatory formats, fostering meaningful dialogue and knowledge exchange.

This year's Conference is expected to provide a unique space of networking, learning, inspiring cultural practice, discussions, enhanced knowledge, and experience.

Workshop types

You will be submitting your proposal for one of the following.

- 1. 25-minute Oral workshop (including 5min Q&A)
- 2. 50-minute Oral workshop (including 5min Q&A)
- 3. 50-minute interactive workshop

Proposal Criteria

Proposals must include the following:

- ✓ Presenter details (name, contact number and email address)
- ✓ Title of presentation or workshop
- ✓ Concise summary of presentation content
- ✓ Brief biography of presenter/s (provide a bio for each presenter and no more than 1 paragraph each)
- ✓ Workshop type (i.e. 25min ORAL workshop, 50min ORAL workshop or 50min interactive workshop)
 - For the interactive workshop Please include a clear outline of what your workshop will involve, whether it will be open or limited to a particular audience and/or number of participants.

- Please note a single registration permits only one person to attend the conference
- If there are co-presenters who would also like to attend the conference, they will need to register and pay for the conference
- Opportunities for workshops are limited, priority will be given to those that provide a detailed proposal.
- You need to be available on either of the days to deliver your workshop (Tuesday & Wednesday). Unfortunately, we are unable to accommodate preferences.
- Information regarding registration for Presenters will be emailed to presenters on acceptance of their proposal.
- Oral workshops will be 20 or 45 minutes each with 5 minutes for Q&A
- Interactive workshops will be a full session of 50minutes. There are limited spaces available.
- To respect each presenters' allocated time, each workshop time will be strictly monitored.
