for a Feminist Essay in 2015

CALL FOR ENTRIES

Entries are open for the 2015 *Women's Studies Journal* Graduate Prize for a Feminist Essay, awarded by the Women's Studies Association, and administered by the editorial collective of the *Women's Studies Journal*. The award will be presented to the author/s of a submitted essay that is considered by the judging panel to best represent feminist scholarship on the 2015 theme: **gender-based violence in contemporary Aotearoa/New Zealand**.

Entries for the 2015 prize will close on **1 June 2015**, and the winning essay will be announced on 1 September 2015. The award consists of a citation from the Women's Studies Association, **\$500**, and consideration for publication in the *Women's Studies Journal*.

Eligibility

To be eligible to enter, you must be enrolled in a graduate degree at a tertiary institution in Aotearoa/New Zealand at the time of writing the essay. All suitable entries will be considered, irrespective of gender identity.

Entries

The essay should be an original piece of work (although not necessarily research-based) that has not been published or accepted for publication. It should be 4,000-5,000 words, and should follow the submission guidelines for the *Women's Studies Journal* (these are available on our website - <http://www.wsanz.org.nz/journal/submissions.htm>). Joint authorship is permitted, subject to both members meeting the eligibility criteria.
